MEDICATION ASSISTED TREATMENT at Allentown Treatment Center

Individuals actively enrolled in our drug and alcohol treatment services can receive medication assisted treatment (MAT) with Vivitrol or Suboxone in conjunction with their treatment services in one convenient location.

These services are appropriate for individuals who are addicted to heroin or other opiates, including prescription painkillers. MAT may also be a solution for those who have attempted other methods of treatment and been unsuccessful.

MAT is a proven, effective option for many individuals struggling to recover from opiate addiction. This treatment method offers a reprieve from the physical symptoms of withdrawal, as well as an opportunity to focus on the support programs and ongoing counseling crucial to leading a healthy, productive journey of recovery.

As part of our program, clients interested in MAT services must meet criteria for treatment services at our program and maintain active participation in scheduled appointments while under our doctor's care.

STEPS TO ACCESS MAT SERVICES

STEP ONE

Access to any services available in our office, including MAT services, starts with a level of care assessment to review which treatment options are the best fit for your needs. To schedule an assessment, contact our central admissions office at 888-694-9996 or stop by for a walk-in assessment at our Allentown office, Monday through Thursday from 8 AM - 2 PM.

STEP TWO

Once a level of care is established and you've chosen to engage in MAT services with us, an initial nursing assessment will be scheduled along with a follow-up treatment appointment to review what, if any, MAT options are right for you. We require an external referral for clients recommended for Vivitrol who have not been previously prescribed or given a shot within 30 days of admission into our program. Our clinical team can assist you with this process.

STEP THREE

After meeting with our nursing team, clients continuing with the MAT process will be scheduled for a physical and medication review with our physician.

STEP FOUR

To ensure ongoing support of all recovery needs, clients engaged in MAT services are required to maintain enrollment in our treatment services in order to remain under our doctor's care. Attend your sessions consistently and engage in regular communication with your primary counselor.
