Life Skills Program

Life skills specialists and clinicians collaborate to provide the client with effective guidance and instruction on topics such as financial management, job preparation, communication skills/social etiquette, and the appropriate utilization of community resources with the goal of functioning productively in society free of drug and/or alcohol dependence. We bring in various professionals like OVR, local banks, and other community agencies to teach clients specific life skills such as job-seeking, money management, interviewing, etc.

Dual-Licensed Healthcare Professionals

Pittsburgh's fully integrated rehabilitation program is dual licensed (RTFA certified by OMHSAS) and led by certified co-occurring disorders professionals in the administrative, supervisory, and clinical positions to diagnose and address client addiction aggravated by mental health conditions including depression, anxiety, bipolar disorder, and mood disorders.

Individualized Educational Tracks

Pittsburgh offers an array of additional educational tracks that offer clients the opportunity to individualize their own treatment experience:

We educate, induct, and maintain clients on all forms of Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) including Suboxone®, Vivitrol®, and Methadone. Physician approval is required for induction while in treatment.
