- » Food or beverages
- » Glass bottles or sharp objects
- » Any item containing alcohol
- » Inappropriate clothing

What Can I Bring to Treatment?

Required

- » Prescription medication in prescription bottle with matching affixed prescription label

Requested Items

- » Insurance card
- » Sealed personal hygiene items including soap, deodorant, shampoo, toothbrush, razor, shower shoes and shaving cream
- » No more than 7 days' worth of clothing
- » Valid ID
- » Unopened tobacco products
- » Cash maximum of \$100.00
